## GUIDELINES FOR QUALIFYING FOR AN EDUCATIONAL SCHOLARSHIP

- 1. Applicant or immediate parents must be active members(e.g. attends community groups, ministry involvement, gives financially to support the ministries of the church).
- 2. Applicants must either be registered as a Graduate student in a seminary institution or a Junior or Senior in any college institution.
- 3. New applicants must provide "Proof of Acceptance" from a graduate seminary or divinity institution. Juniors or seniors already in an approved college must provide "Evidence of Good Standing."
- 4. Applications must include a letter from applicant explaining why a scholarship (donation) is deserved. A Letter of Testimony is required for scholarship.
- 5. Scholarships (donations) will be made available once a year. Applications must be submitted no later than Friday, June 30, 2023 at 12:30 p.m.
- 6. Application process may include a personal interview with one or more FBC Foundation Trustees.
- 7. Application, Letter of Testimony, and Letter explaining why a scholarship is deserved must be returned to FBC business office or emailed to <u>kenton@fbcdothan.org</u>.
